The type of event and number of guests will determine the minimum amount of space required. Below is a quick reference guide to help you get started

Keep in mind that all of our tents can be connected together to create a larger space for your event. For example our MQ40Hex tent can be connected to a MQ20 giving you 1440sqft of unobstructed space.

Also remember to calculate additional sqft if you plan to rent a dance floor (256sqft) Dj services (100sqft) or intend to have a buffet line (50sqft per 8' banquet)

Formula: # Guests X Table Style +Additional sq footage = Total square footage required.

Example: 50 Guests X 12 SQFT (5'Rounds) +100sqft (DJ) = 700sqft A 20X40 or MQ40Hex tent would be suitable for this event.
